

Judicial primary will be lone race Tuesday

Ozaukee County voters will cast their ballots in a primary for Wisconsin supreme court judge Tuesday, Feb. 19.

It is the only race on the primary ballot.

The three candidates include incumbent Justice Pat Roggensack and challengers Vince Megna and Ed Fallon. The top two vote-getters in the nonpartisan race will claim places on the April 2 general election ballot.

Justices are elected to 10-year terms.
